



*Congregation Notes Torah Portion BaMidbar - In the Wilderness -  
"The End Time Army"*

*June 8, 2024 - Sivan 2 5784*

*Numbers 1:1-4:20; Hosea 2:1-2:20; Mathew 4:1-17*

**\*Exodus 19:1** At the third new moon after the Israelites had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that very day, they came into the wilderness of Sinai.

**\*Ruth 2:23** So Ruth stayed close to the women of Boaz to glean until the barley and wheat harvests were finished. And she lived with her mother-in-law.

**\*Exodus 19:11** and prepare for the third day, because on the third day the Lord will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.

**\*Acts 2:1-4** When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

**\*Exodus 19:16&18** Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because the Lord descended upon it in fire. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly.

**\*Zechariah 8:3** Thus says the LORD: I will return to Zion, and dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, the Mountain of the LORD of hosts, the Holy Mountain.

**\*Genesis 46:27** And the sons of Joseph who were born to him in Egypt were two persons; thus all the persons of the house of Jacob who came into Egypt were seventy.

**\*Exodus 12:37-38** The Israelites journeyed from Rameses to Succoth with about 600,000 men on foot, besides women and children. And a mixed multitude also went up with them, along with great droves of livestock, both flocks and herds....

**\*Exodus 15:3 (they sing) The LORD is a man of war  
The LORD is His name....**

**\*Numbers 1:1-4** Now the Lord spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, in the tabernacle of meeting, on the first day of the second month, in the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying: Take a census of all the congregation of the children of Israel, by their families, by their fathers' houses, according to the number of names, every male individually, <sup>3</sup>from twenty years old and above—all who are able to go to war in Israel. You and Aaron shall number them by their armies. <sup>4</sup>And with you there shall be a man from every tribe, each one the head of his father's house.

**\*Numbers 1:2** Take a census of all the congregation of the children of Israel, by their families, by their fathers' houses, according to the number of names, every male individually,

**\*Daniel 8:9-12** And out of one of them came a little horn which grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the *Glorious Land*. And it grew up to the **host** **אֲרָצָה** of heaven; and it cast down some of the host and some of the stars to the ground, and trampled them. He even exalted himself as high as the Prince of the host; and by him the daily sacrifices were taken away, and the place of His sanctuary was cast down. Because of transgression, an army was given over to the horn to oppose the daily sacrifices; and he cast truth down to the ground. He did all this and prospered.

**\*Joshua 5:15** Then the Commander of the Lord's **army** **אֲרָצָה** said to Joshua, Take your sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand is holy. And Joshua did so.

**\*Psalm 125:2** As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds His people, from this time forth and forevermore. He surrounds His people.

**\*Ephesians 1:19-22** and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He exerted in Messiah when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. And God put everything under His feet and made Him head over everything for the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.....

**\*Luke 10:19** I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.

**\*Malachi 4:1 & 3-4** For behold, the day is coming, Burning like an oven, And all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn them up, Says the Lord of hosts, That will leave them neither root nor branch.....You shall trample



**\*Acts 1:8a** you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you;

**\*2 Timothy 2:4** No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

**\*Galatians 5:22-23** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

**\*Numbers 1:2** Take a census of all the congregation of the children of Israel, by their families, by heir father's houses, according to the number of names of every male individually.

**\*John 10:27-29** My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them out of My hand. My Father who has given them to Me is greater than all. No one can snatch them out of My Father's hand....

**\*Ephesians 3:5**....the Gentiles should be fellow heirs of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Yeshua through the gospel.

**\*I Corinthians 6:19** What? Do you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which you have of God, and you are not your own?

**\*Ephesians 2:8** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

**\*II Corinthians 5:17** Therefore if any man be in Messiah, he is a new creature; old things are passed away, behold all things are become new.

**\*Ephesians 2:3b** .....we were by nature children of wrath,

**\*Romans 6:19** I speak in human terms on account of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you yielded your members in bondage to impurity and to lawlessness unto lawlessness, so now yield your members in bondage to righteousness unto sanctification.

**\*2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Messiah, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

**\*I Corinthians 6:19** What? do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have of God, and you are not your own?

**\*Joel 3:9** Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war! Rouse the warriors! Let all the fighting men draw near and attack.
