



*Congregation Notes Torah Portion Shelach - Send Forth
"Prophecy Being Unveiled - One New Man"*

June 29, 2024; Sivan 23, 5784

Numbers 13:1 - 15:41; Joshua 2:1-24; Matthew 10:1-14

***Numbers 12:9-16** So the anger of the Lord was aroused against them, and He departed. And when the cloud departed from above the tabernacle, suddenly Miriam became leprous, as white as snow. Then Aaron turned toward Miriam, and there she was, a leper. So Aaron said to Moses, Oh, my lord! Please do not lay this sin on us, in which we have done foolishly and in which we have sinned. Please do not let her be as one dead, whose flesh is half consumed when he comes out of his mother's womb!

So Moses cried out to the Lord, saying, Please heal her, O God, I pray!

***Deuteronomy 18:18** I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers.

***Luke 23:34a** Then Jesus said, Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.

(*Numbers 12:9-16 cont.) Then the Lord said to Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, would she not be shamed seven days? Let her be shut out of the camp seven days, and afterward she may be received again. So Miriam was shut out of the camp seven days, and the people did not journey till Miriam was brought in again. And afterward the people moved from Hazeroth and camped in the Wilderness of Paran.

***Numbers 13:1-2** HASHEM spoke to Moses, saying, **Send out for you men** and let them **spy out** the Land of Canaan that I am giving to the Children of Israel.

***Numbers 13:3** Moses sent them forth from the Wilderness of Paran according to the word of HASHEM; **they were all distinguished men; heads** of the Children of Israel were they.

***Genesis 12:7** To your offspring I will give this land.

***Genesis 15:18** To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt as far as the great river the river Euphrates.

***Genesis 17:8** The whole land of Canaan, where you now reside as a foreigner, **I will give as an everlasting possession** to you and your descendants after you.

***Genesis 26:3-4** Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform the oath which I swore to Abraham your father. And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed;

***Genesis 28:13** I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants.

***Exodus 3:17** And I have promised to bring you up out of your misery in Egypt into the land of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites—a land flowing with milk and honey.

***Numbers 13:3& 6-8** So Moses sent them from the Wilderness of Paran according to the command of the Lord, all of them men who were heads of the children of Israel. from the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh; from the tribe of Issachar, Igal the son of Joseph; from the tribe of Ephraim, Hoshea the son of Nun;

***Genesis 15:18-19** To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates— the Kenites, the Kenezites, the Kadmonites,

***Matthew 1:1-2 & 16** The book of the genealogy of Yeshua Messiah, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham: Abraham begot Isaac, Isaac begot Jacob, and Jacob begot Judah and his brothers..... And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Yeshua who is called Messiah.

***Joshua 14:13-14** Then Joshua blessed Caleb son of Jephunneh and gave him Hebron as his inheritance. So Hebron has belonged to Caleb son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite ever since, because he followed the LORD, the God of Israel, wholeheartedly.

***Numbers 13:16** Moses called Hoshea (Joshua) son of Nun Yhoshua.

***Numbers 13:21-24** So they went up and explored the land from the Desert of Zin as far as Rehob, toward Lebo Hamath. They went up through the Negev and came to Hebron, where Ahiman, Sheshai and Talmi, the descendants of Anak, lived. (Hebron had been built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.) When they reached the Valley of Eshkol, they cut off a branch bearing a single cluster of grapes. Two of them carried it on a pole between them, along with some pomegranates and figs. That place he named the Valley of Eshkol because of the cluster of grapes the Israelites cut off there.

***Genesis 6:4** The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and afterward as well—when the sons of God had relations with the daughters of men. And they bore them children who became the mighty men of old, men of renown.

***Numbers 13:33** We even saw the Nephilim there—the descendants of Anak that come from the Nephilim! We seemed like grasshoppers in our own sight, and we must have seemed the same to them!

***Numbers 13:25-26** When they returned from spying out the land, at the end of forty days, they came to Moses and Aaron and to all the congregation of the sons of Israel in the Wilderness of Paran at Kadesh and brought back word to them and to all the congregation, and showed them the land's fruit.

***Numbers 13:29** The Amalekites dwell in the land of the South; the Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the mountains; and the Canaanites dwell by the sea and along the banks of the Jordan.

***Numbers 13:30** Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses and said, We must go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly conquer it!

***Numbers 13:31-33** But the men who had gone up with him said, We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we. So they gave the Israelites a bad report about the land that they had spied out: The land we explored devours its inhabitants, and all the people we saw there are great in stature. We even saw the Nephilim there—the descendants of Anak that come from the Nephilim! We seemed like grasshoppers in our own sight, and we must have seemed the same to them!

***Mark 11:23** Truly I tell you that if anyone says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea, and has no doubt in his heart but believes that it will happen, it will be done for him.

I Samuel 17:10 & 16 & 32&37B &45-46&50 Then the Philistine said, This day I defy the armies of Israel! Give me a man and let us fight each other. On hearing the Philistine's words, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified. David said to Saul, Let no one lose heart on account of this Philistine; your servant will go and fight him. Saul said to David, Go, and the Lord be with you. David said to the Philistine, You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the Lord will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds and the wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. So **David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand** he struck down the Philistine and killed him.

***II Samuel 22:15** He shot his arrows and scattered the enemy, with great bolts of lightning he routed them. The valleys of the sea were exposed and the foundations of the earth laid bare at the rebuke of the LORD, at the blast of breath from his nostrils. He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters. He rescued me from my powerful enemy, from my foes, who were too strong for me. They confronted me in the day of my disaster, but the LORD was my support.

***Ezekiel 37:16-17** As for you, son of man, take a stick for yourself and write on it: For Judah and for the children of Israel, his companions. Then take another stick and write on it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel, his companions. Then join them one to another for yourself into one stick, and they will become one in your hand.

***Ezekiel 37:24** David My Servant shall be king over them and they shall all have one shepherd, they shall also walk in My judgments and observe My statutes and do them.

***Psalm 132:11** The LORD hath sworn in truth unto DAVID; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy (David's) throne.

***Ezekiel 37:21** Then say to them, Thus says the Lord God: Surely I will take the children of Israel from among the nations, wherever they have gone, and will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land;

***Ezekiel 37:22** And I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel. And one king shall be king over them all, and they shall be no longer two nations, and no longer divided into two kingdoms.

***Revelation 5:9** You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth.....

***Revelation 6:17** For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?

***Obadiah 1:19-21** The South shall possess the mountains of Esau, And the lowland shall possess Philistia. They shall possess the fields of Ephraim and the fields of Samaria. Benjamin shall possess Gilead. And the captives of this host of the children of Israel Shall possess the land of the Canaanites as far as Zarephath. The captives of Jerusalem who are in Sepharad shall possess the cities of the South. Then saviors shall come to Mount Zion to judge the mountains of Esau, and the kingdom shall be the Lord's.

***Revelation 19:15-16** Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING OF KINGS AND
LORD OF LORDS.
