

Congregation Notes Torah Portion Ki Tavo Joy At the End and Holy Spirit's Power to Help Sept. 21, 2024 ; Elul 18, 5784 Deuteronomy 26:1-29:8; Isaíah 60:1-22; Matthew 4:13-24

*Deuteronomy 26:1-3 And it shall be, when you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it, that you shall take some of the <u>first of all the produce of the ground</u>, which you shall bring from your land that the Lord your God is giving you, and put it in a basket and <u>go to the place where the Lord your God</u> <u>chooses to make His name abide</u>. And you shall <u>go to the one who is priest in those days</u>, and say to him, <u>I declare today to the Lord your God that I have come to the country</u> <u>which the Lord swore to our fathers to give us</u>.

*John 4:23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the <u>true worshipers will worship the</u> <u>Father in the Spirit and in truth</u>, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

*Psalm 33:6 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host.

*Hebrews 1:1 In the past <u>God spoke to our forefathers</u> [He revealed Himself] through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days <u>He has spoken to us by His</u> <u>Son,.....</u>

***Psalm 111:9** He has sent redemption to His people; He has <u>commanded His covenant</u> <u>forever</u>....

***Isaiah 30:21** And thine <u>ears shall hear a word behind thee</u>, saying, This *is* the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

*Matthew 7:24 Therefore everyone who <u>hears these words</u> of <u>Mine</u>, and <u>acts upon them</u>, may be compared to a wise man, who built his house upon the rock.

*Deuteronomy 26:17-18 Today <u>you have chosen (avouched, acknowledged, accepted,</u> <u>obtained) the Lord to be your God</u>, and that <u>you will walk in His ways</u> and <u>keep His</u> <u>statutes</u>, His commandments, and His judgments, and that you will <u>obey His voice</u>.

*Isaiah 49:3-4 And <u>He said</u>, אמר to me You are My servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified. Then I said, I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nothing and in vain; Yet surely <u>my just reward is with the LORD</u>, <u>and my work with my God</u>.

* Psalm 128:1 Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, Who walks in His ways.

*Matthew 25:35-36 For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you took Me in, I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you looked after Me, I was in prison and you visited Me.

*Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

***Romans 2:14-15** Even Gentiles, who do not have God's written law, show that they know His law when they instinctively obey it, even without having heard it. They demonstrate that God's law is written in their hearts, for their own conscience and thoughts either accuse them or tell them they are doing right.

*Mark 12:30-31 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: Love your neighbor as yourself. <u>There</u> is no commandment greater than these.

*Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, that <u>they may see your</u> good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

*Deuteronomy 26:18-19 <u>Also today</u> the Lord has proclaimed you to be His special people, just as He promised you, that you should keep all His commandments, and that <u>He will set you high</u> <u>above all nations which He has made</u>, in praise, in name, and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, just as He has spoken.

*Deuteronomy 29:1 These are the words of the covenant which the Lord commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant which He made with them in Horeb.

***Exodus 20:2-3** I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. <u>You shall not have other gods beside me</u>.

*Deuteronomy 28:47-48 Because <u>you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and</u> <u>gladness of heart</u>, <u>for the abundance of everything</u>, <u>therefore</u> you shall serve your enemies, whom the LORD will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in nakedness, and in need of everything; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.

*Jeremiah 30:4-7 Now these are the words which the LORD spoke concerning Israel and concerning Judah: For thus says the LORD, I have heard a sound of terror, of dread, and there is no peace. Ask now and see if a male can give birth. Why do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in childbirth? And why have all faces turned pale? Alas, what a <u>terrible</u> <u>time of trouble</u> it is! There has never been any like it. <u>It is a time of trouble for the</u> <u>descendants of Jacob</u>, but <u>some of them will be rescued out of it</u>.

***Daniel 9:27** Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.

*Matthew 24:15-22 So when you see standing in the holy place <u>the abomination that causes</u> <u>desolation</u>, <u>spoken of through the prophet Daniel</u>—let the reader understand— then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. Let no one on the housetop go down to take anything out of the house. Let no one in the field go back to get their cloak. How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! Pray that your flight will not take place in winter or on the Sabbath. For then there will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world until now—and never to be equaled again. If those days had not been

cut short, no one would survive, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened.

*Deuteronomy 28:47-48 Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything,

*Proverbs 17:22 A joyful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones. Heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

*2 Corinthians 9:6-8 Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

*Colossians 3:17 And <u>whatever you do</u>, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

*Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Yeshua the Messiah was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, <u>she was found with child of the Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>.

*Luke 2:25-26 And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and <u>the Holy Spirit was upon him</u>. And <u>it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit</u> that <u>he would not see death</u> <u>before he had seen the Lord's Messiah</u>.

*John 3:34 For the One whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for <u>God gives the</u> <u>Spirit without limit</u>.

*Matthew 4:1 Then <u>Yeshua was led up by the Spirit</u> into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

*Luke 4:18-19 The <u>Spirit of the Lord</u> is upon Me, because <u>He has anointed Me to preach</u> the gospel to the poor; <u>He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted</u>, to <u>proclaim liberty</u> to the captives and <u>recovery of sight to the blind</u>, to <u>set at liberty those who are oppressed</u>; to <u>proclaim</u> the acceptable year of the LORD.

*Acts 1:4-5 And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, which, He said, you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but <u>you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit</u> not many days from now.

*John 14:8-9 Philip said to him, Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us. Yeshua said to him, Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has <u>seen</u> <u>Me has seen the Father</u>. How can you say, Show us the Father?

*John 14:18 <u>I will not leave you comfortless</u>; I will come to you.

*John 14:16 <u>And I will pray the Father</u>, and <u>He shall give you another Comforter</u>, that he may abide with you forever.

*John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and <u>He will give you another</u> Helper, that He may abide with you forever.

*John 7:39 He was speaking about the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were later to receive. For the Spirit had not yet been given, because Yeshua had not yet been glorified.

***Psalm 51:10-12** Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from Your presence, **take not your Holy Spirit from me**. <u>Restore to me the joy</u> of Your salvation, and sustain me with a willing spirit....

*Hebrews 1:3a The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the <u>exact representation</u> of His nature, upholding all things by His powerful word.....

*Matthew 9:35-38 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing every sickness and every</u> <u>disease among the people</u>.

*1 John 2:27 But the anointing that you received from him abides in you, and you have no need that anyone should teach you.

*Isaiah 60:1–2 Arise, shine; For <u>your light has come</u>! And the <u>glory of the Lord is risen</u> <u>upon you</u>. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the <u>Lord will arise over you</u>, <u>And His glory will be seen upon you</u>.
