**How We Know We Are Living In the Days Like Noah's**  
**November 2, 2024 - 1 Chesvan, 5785**  
**Genesis 6:9-11;32; Isaiah 66:1-24; Mark 9:40-50**

**\*Genesis 6:1-4** Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, that the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose. And the Lord said, My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years. **There were giants נפיל on the earth in those days**, and also afterward, when the sons of God came into the daughters of men and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old.

**\*Mark 12:20-25** Now there were seven brothers. The first took a wife; and dying, he left no offspring. And the second took her, and he died; nor did he leave any offspring. And the third likewise. So the seven had her and left no offspring. Last of all the woman died also. <sup>23</sup> Therefore, in the resurrection, when they rise, whose wife will she be? For all seven had her as wife.

Yeshua answered and said to them, Are you not therefore mistaken, because you do not know the Scriptures nor the power of God? For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

**\*Numbers 13:28** Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong the cities are fortified and very large; moreover, we saw the descendants of Anak there.

**\*Numbers 13:33** There we saw the giants הנפילים (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight.

**\*Genesis 6:5-7** Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. **And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth**, and He was grieved in His heart. So the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them.

**\*Genesis 6:8** But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

**\*Genesis 8:4** Then the ark rested ארצו in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.



**\*Matthew 11:28-29** Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

**\*Exodus 20:9-11** Six days you shall labor and do all your work for in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them and rested **יָנַח** the seventh **הַשְּׁבִיעִי** day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath **הַשַּׁבָּת** and consecrated it.

**\*Hebrews 4: 9-11** There remains, **(it remains it is reserved)** then, a Sabbath rest for the people of God. For whoever enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from His. Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following the same pattern of disobedience.

**\*Ecclesiastes 1:9** What has been is what will be, and what has been done is what will be done; there is nothing new under the sun.

**\*2 Thessalonians 2:3-5** Let no one deceive you in any way, for it will not come until the rebellion occurs and the man of lawlessness—the son of destruction—is revealed. He will oppose and exalt himself above every so-called god or object of worship. So he will seat himself in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God. Do you not remember that I told you these things while I was still with you?

**\*Hebrews 4:6-10** Since therefore it remains that some *must* enter it, (MEANING REST) and those to whom it was first preached did not enter because of disobedience, again He designates a certain day, saying in David, 'Today,' after such a long time, as it has been said:

*' Today, if you will hear His voice,*

*Do not harden your hearts.'* For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day. There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

**\*2 Peter 3:8** But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

**\*Revelation 20:1-4** Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into

the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished.

**\*Genesis 6:9** This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just. צַדִּיק man, perfect תְּמִים in his generations. Noah walked with God.

**\*Matthew 18:2-3** ...Yeshua invited a little child to stand among them and said: Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven....

**\*Genesis 6:10-12** And Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. חָמָס So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.

**\*Genesis 6:5-6** Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved נָחַם in His heart.

**\*Genesis 6:13-15a** And God said to Noah, The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence חָמָס through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth. Make yourself an ark of gopherwood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with pitch. And this is how you shall make it:

**\*2 Peter 2:5** <sup>5</sup> and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

**\*Hebrews 11:7** By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

**\*Hebrews 9:3-4** and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All, which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all



sides with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant;

**\*Genesis 6:22** Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did.

**\*Genesis 7:5** And Noah did according to all that the Lord commanded him.

**\*Genesis 7:1,6** Then the Lord said to Noah, "Come into the ark, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation.....6) And Noah did according to all that the Lord commanded him.

**\*Genesis 8:15-18** Then God spoke to Noah, saying, "Go out of the ark, you and your wife, and your sons and your sons' wives with you. <sup>17</sup> Bring out with you every living thing of all flesh that is with you: birds and cattle and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, so that they may abound on the earth, and be fruitful and multiply on the earth." So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him.

**\*Matthew 24:37-39** But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

**\*EZEKIEL 38:9** YOU SHALL ADVANCE , **COMING LIKE A STORM**, LIKE A WIDE-RANGING DISASTER UPON THE WORLD; YOU WILL BE LIKE A DARK CLOUD THAT DESCENDS TO COVER THE LAND, YOU AND ALL YOUR TROOPS AND THE MANY PEOPLES THAT ARE WITH YOU.

**\*PSALM 35:10** ALL MY BONES SHALL SAY, LORD, WHO IS LIKE YOU? YOU SAVE THE POOR FROM ONE STRONGER THAN HE, THE POOR AND NEEDY FROM HIS DESPOILER.

**\*PSALM 35:11** False witnesses rise up; they ask me of things that I know not.

**\*PSALM 25:18-20** Look at my affliction and suffering, and forgive all my sins. See how **numerous my enemies are**, and how unjustly they hate me!

**\*EZEKIEL 38:1-3** The word of GOD came to me:

Oh, mortal man, turn your face toward Gog of the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal. Prophecy against him and say: Thus said the Sovereign GOD: Lo, I am coming to deal with you, O Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal!
