MOSES, THE REMNANT AND THE LAST DAYS  
Exodus 1:1-6:1; Isaiah 27:6-28; 13; 29:22-23; Matthew 2:1-12

**\*Shemot (Exodus) 1:1** And these are the names of the Children of Israel who were coming to Egypt; with Jacob, each man and his household came.

**\*Isaiah 9:6** For unto us a son is given....

**\*Luke 9:35** This is my beloved son, hear Him.

**\*Ephesians 2:13** But now, in union with the Messiah Yeshua, you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of the Messiah.

**\*2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore if any man be in Messiah, he is a new creation.

**\*John 16:33** Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.

**\*I Timothy 6:12** Fight the good fight of faith.

**\*Galatians 6:2** Bear one another's burdens....

**\*Colossians 3:23** Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men....

**\*I Corinthians 6:20** For you were bought at a price, therefore, glorify HaShem in your body.

**\*Matthew 28:18** Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations.

**\*Psalm 144:15** Happy are the people whose God is the LORD!

**\*Acts 7:56** Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God.

**\*Genesis 46:8** And these are the names of the Children of Israel, Jacob and his sons, who went to Egypt.

**\*Genesis 50:26** So Joseph died, being one hundred and ten years old; and they embalmed him, and he was put in a coffin in Egypt.

**\*Genesis. 15:18** Then he said to Abram, Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs and will serve them.....

**\*Exodus 1:5** And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls; and Joseph was in Egypt already.

**\*Deuteronomy 7:6** For you are a people set apart as holy for the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be his own unique treasure.

**\*Isaiah 43:21a** This people I have formed for Myself.....

**\*Exodus 4:22-23a** Then tell Pharaoh that this is what the LORD says: 'Israel is My firstborn son and I told you to let My son go so that he may worship Me.

**\*Hosea 11:1** When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son.

**\*Matthew 2:15** and there he remained until the death of Herod, so that it might be fulfilled what had been spoken by Lord through the prophet, saying, "Out of Egypt I have called my Son."

**\*Exodus 1:7-9** But the children of Israel were fruitful and increased abundantly, multiplied and grew exceedingly mighty; and the land was filled with them. Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. And he said to his people, Look, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we;

**\*Exodus 1:13-14b** The Egyptians worked the Israelites ruthlessly and made their lives bitter with hard labor in brick and mortar, and with all kinds of work in the fields. Every service they imposed was with crushing harshness.

**\*Exodus 6:20** Amram took as his wife Jochebed his father's sister, and she bore him Aaron and Moses,.....

**\*Exodus 1:15-16** Then the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other Puah, When you serve as midwife to the Hebrew women and see them on the birthstool, if it is a son, you shall kill him, but if it is a daughter, she shall live. The midwives, however, feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt had instructed; they let the boys live.

**\*Exodus 1:18-19** So the king of Egypt called for the midwives and said to them, Why have you done this thing, and saved the male children alive? And the midwives said to Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women; for they are lively and give birth before the midwives come to them.

**\*I Chronicles 4:18** And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these are the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

**\*Exodus 2:11-12** It came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brothers, and looked on their suffering; and he saw an Egyptian hitting a Hebrew, one of his brothers. He looked this way and that, and when he saw that there was no man, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand.

**\*Exodus 2:13-15** And when he went out the second day, behold, two Hebrew men were fighting, and he said to the one who did the wrong, Why are you striking your companion? Then he said, Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian? So Moses feared and said, Surely this thing is known! When Pharaoh heard of this matter, he sought to kill Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh and dwelt in the land of Midian; and he sat down by a well

**\*Exodus 2:23-25** Now it happened in the process of time that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of the bondage. So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged them.

**\*Exodus 3:1-6** Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb,

**\*Matthew 5:17-18** Don't think that I have come to abolish the Torah or the Prophets. I have come not to abolish but to complete. Yes indeed! I tell you that until heaven and earth pass away, not so much as a yud or a stroke will pass from the Torah — not until everything that must happen has happened.

(Ex.3:1-6 CONT.) the mountain of God. And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame תַּלְתֵּי of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire,

**\*Exodus 13:21-22** And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night. He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people.

**\*Exodus 3:1-6 cont.** but the bush was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn." So when the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then He said, "Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground." Moreover He said, "I am the God of your father--the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.

**\*1 Samuel 14:4** Between the passes, by which Jonathan sought to go over to the Philistines' garrison, there was a sharp rock on one side and a sharp rock on the other side. And the name of one was Bozez, and the name of the other Seneh. 5 The front of one faced northward opposite Michmash, and the other southward opposite Gibeah.

**\*Romans 12:11** Do not lag in zeal (hitla'avut) ; be fervent in spirit. Keep serving the Lord.

**\*Exodus 3:8a-10** I have descended to rescue them from the hand of Egypt and to bring them up to the land that is good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey,....And now indeed! the outcry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and also I have seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. And now go. I shall send you to Pharaoh, and you shall take out My people the Children of Israel from Egypt.

**\*Exodus 3:12** He replied, "I will surely be with you. Your sign that I have sent you will be that when you have led the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain.

**\*Exodus 9:13** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Get up early in the morning, stand before Pharaoh, and tell him that this is what the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, says: 'Let My people go, so that they may worship וְעַבְדוּ Me.

**\*I Thessalonians 5:16-17** Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Messiah Yeshua for you.

**\*Exodus 13:13-15** And Moses said unto God: 'Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them: The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me: What is His name? what shall I say unto them?' And God said unto Moses: 'I AM THAT I AM'; and He said: 'Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel: I AM hath sent me unto you. And God said moreover unto Moses: 'Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel: The LORD, יהוה, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you; this is My name for ever, and this is My memorial unto all generations.

**\*Deuteronomy 6:4** "Hear, O Israel: The LORD, יהוה, our God, the LORD יהוה is One."

**\*Revelation 8:7** The first angel sounded his trumpet, and there came hail and fire mixed with blood, and it was hurled down on the earth. A third of the earth was burned up, a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.
