

## Congregation Notes Torah Portion Noach As In The Days Of Noah! We Have Arrived! Oct. 25,2025

Genesis 6:9-11:32; Isaiah 66:1-24; Mark 9:40-50

\*Genesis 1:26 Then God said, Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness....

\*Micah 6:8 He has shown you, O man, what *is* good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

\*Genesis 6:9 <u>These are the generations</u> of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and <u>Noah walked with God</u>.

\*Genesis 2:4 These are the generations תּוֹלְדָּוֹת of heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made earth and heaven.

\*Ruth 4:13b-15, 18 And the LORD enabled her [Ruth] to conceive, and she gave birth to a son [Obed]. Then the women said to Naomi, Blessed is the LORD who has not left you without a redeemer today, and may his name become famous in Israel. May he also be to you a restorer of life and a sustainer of your old age; for your daughter-in-law, who loves you and is better to you than seven sons, has given birth to him...

...Now these are the **generations** (תּוֹלְדְּוֹת) of Perez: to Perez was born Hezron and to Hezron was born Ram, and to Ram, Amminadab, and to Amminadab was born Nahshon, and to Nahshon, Salmon, and to Salmon was born Boaz, and to Boaz, Obed, and to Obed was born Jesse, and to Jesse, David.

\*Matthew 1:1 The book of the genealogy of <u>Yeshua the Messiah</u>, the Son of <u>David</u>, the Son of <u>Abraham</u>.

\*Genesis 6:10 And Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

\*Genesis 6:11 Now the earth was corrupt in the sight of God, and full of violence.

\*Amos 3:10 The LORD has said that they don't even know how to do right. They have become rich from violence and robbery.

- \*Genesis 6:11-13 The <u>earth also was corrupt before God</u>, and the <u>earth was filled with violence</u>. 12So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for <u>all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth</u>. 13And God said to Noah, The end of <u>all flesh</u> has come before Me, for the <u>earth is filled with violence</u> through them; and behold, <u>I will destroy them</u> with the earth.
- \*Genesis 7:21 And every living thing that moved upon the earth perished—birds, livestock, animals, every creature that swarms upon the earth, and all mankind.
- \*Genesis 18:27-33 Then Abraham spoke up again: "Now that I have been so bold as to speak to the Lord, though I am nothing but dust and ashes, <sup>28</sup> what if the number of the righteous is five less than fifty? Will you destroy the whole city for lack of five people?" "If I find forty-five there," he said, "I will not destroy it." <sup>29</sup> Once again he spoke to him, "What if only forty are found there?" He said, "For the sake of forty, I will not do it."
- \*Genesis 19:14-29 So Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who were pledged to marry his daughters. He said, Hurry and get out of this place, because the Lord is about to destroy the city! But his sons-in-law thought he was joking. 15 With the coming of dawn, the angels urged Lot, saying, Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished. 16 When he hesitated, the men grasped his hand and the hands of his wife and of his two daughters and led them safely out of the city, for the Lord was merciful to them. <sup>17</sup> As soon as they had brought them out, one of them said, Flee for your lives! Don't look back, and don't stop anywhere in the plain! Flee to the mountains or you will be swept away! <sup>18</sup> But Lot said to them, No, my lords, please! <sup>19</sup> Your servant has found favor in your eyes, and you have shown great kindness to me in sparing my life. But I can't flee to the mountains; this disaster will overtake me, and I'll die. 20 Look, here is a town near enough to run to, and it is small. Let me flee to it—it is very small, isn't it? Then my life will be spared."21 He said to him, Very well, I will grant this request too; I will not overthrow the town you speak of.<sup>22</sup> But flee there quickly, because I cannot do anything until you reach it. (That is why the town was called Zoar.)<sup>23</sup> By the time Lot reached Zoar, the sun had risen over the land. 24 Then the Lord rained down burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah—from the Lord out of the heavens. <sup>25</sup>Thus he overthrew those cities and the entire plain, destroying all those living in the cities—and also the vegetation in the land. <sup>26</sup> But Lot's wife looked back, and she became a pillar of salt.
- \*Psalm 86:11 Teach me Your way, O LORD, that I may walk in Your truth. Give me an undivided heart, that I may fear Your name.
- \*Psalm 25:8-9 Good and upright is the Lord; therefore He instructs sinners in His ways. <sup>9</sup>He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them His way.
- \*Exodus 17:14 Then the LORD said to Moses, Write this for a memorial in the book and recount it in the hearing of Joshua, that <u>I will utterly blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven</u>.

- \*I Samuel 15:2-3 This is what the LORD of Hosts says: 'I witnessed what the Amalekites did to the Israelites when they opposed them on their way up from Egypt. / Now go and attack the Amalekites and devote to destruction all that belongs to them. Do not spare them, but put to death men and women, children and infants, oxen and sheep, camels and donkeys.
- \*Amos 1:6-7 Thus says the Lord: "For three <u>transgressions of Gaza, and for four</u>, I will not turn away its punishment, <u>because they took captive the whole captivity To deliver them up to Edom</u>. <sup>Z</sup> But I will send a fire upon the wall of Gaza, Which shall <u>devour its palaces</u>.
- \*I Samuel 5:13 Now go and attack the Amalekites and devote to destruction all that belongs to them. Do not spare them, but put to death men and women, children and infants, oxen and sheep, camels and donkeys.
- \*Genesis 11:1&4 Now the whole earth had one language and one speech. ....<sup>4</sup> And they said, Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top is in the heavens; let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth.
- \*Job 21:9-11 Their houses are safe from fear,

**Neither is the rod of God upon them.** <sup>10</sup> Their **bull breeds without failure**; their cow calves without miscarriage.

<sup>11</sup>They <u>send forth their little ones like a flock</u>, and their children dance. <sup>12</sup>They sing to the tambourine and harp, and rejoice to the sound of the flute. <sup>13</sup>They spend their days in wealth,

## \*Job 21:14-15 Yet they say to God, 'Depart from us,

For we do not desire the knowledge of Your ways.

- <sup>15</sup>Who is the Almighty, that we should serve Him? And what profit do we have if we pray to Him? <sup>16</sup>Indeed their prosperity is not in their hand;the counsel of the wicked is far from me.
- \*Matthew 24:37-38 As it was in the days of Noah, so will it be at the coming of the Son of Man. 38 For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark....
- \*Exodus 32:6 And the people sat to eat and drink.... etc
- . \*Genesis 15:18 On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying:
- **"Genesis 15:18** To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates—
- \*Leviticus 25:23a23 'The land shall not be sold permanently, for the land is Mine
