Deuteronomy 14:17-16:18

***Deuteronomy 16:9** You shall count seven weeks for yourself; begin to count the seven weeks from the time you begin to put the sickle to the grain.

***Ruth 1:20-21** Do not call me Naomi, she replied. Call me Mara, because the Almighty has dealt quite bitterly with me.

I went away full, but the LORD has brought me back empty. Why call me Naomi? After all, the LORD has testified against me, and the Almighty has afflicted me. So Naomi returned from the land of Moab with her daughter-in-law Ruth the Moabitess. And they arrived in Bethlehem at the beginning of the barley harvest.

***Deuteronomy 16:16-17** Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses at the Feast of unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles; and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed. Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God which He has given you.

***Hosea 2:19** And I will betroth you to me forever. I will betroth you to me in righteousness and in justice, in steadfast love and in mercy.

***Hosea 2:19** I will make you my wife forever, showing you righteousness and justice, unfailing love and compassion.

***Acts 2:1-4** When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

***Acts 2:33** Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this which you both see and hear.

***Acts 1:8** You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

***Revelation 6:5-6** When He broke the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, "Come." I looked, and behold, a black horse; and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. And I heard something like a voice in the center of the four living creatures saying, A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not damage the oil and the wine.

***Zechariah 4:3-6** Also there are two olive trees by it, one on the right of the bowl and the other on its left. I asked the angel who talked with me, What are these, my lord? He answered, Do you not know what these are? No, my lord, I replied. So he said to me, This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the Lord Almighty.

***Isaiah 61:1** The **Spirit** of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners;

***Acts 10:38** You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

***Acts 1:8** You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

***Matthew 26:28-30** This wine is My blood, which will be poured out to forgive the sins of many and begin the new agreement from God to his people. I want you to know, I will not drink this wine again until that day when we are together in my Father's kingdom and the wine is new. Then I will drink it again with you.

***Deuteronomy 16:9a** You shall count seven weeks for yourself;

***2 Peter 3:10-11** But the Day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and its works will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to conduct yourselves in holiness and godliness as you anticipate and hasten the coming of the day of God, when the heavens will be destroyed by fire and the elements will melt in the heat....

***Ephesians 5:27** That He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

***Isaiah 9:7** Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish and sustain it with justice and righteousness from that time and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of Hosts will accomplish this.

***Genesis 15:12-14** As the sun was setting, Abram fell into a deep sleep, and suddenly great terror and darkness overwhelmed him years. Then the LORD said to Abram, Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not their own, and they will be enslaved and mistreated four hundred years. But I will judge the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will depart with many possessions....

***Ezekiel 16:5-6...5** No one cared enough for you to do even one of these things out of compassion for you. Instead, you were thrown out into the open field, because you were despised on the day of your birth. Then I passed by and saw you wallowing in your blood, and as you lay there in your blood I said to you, "Live!" there I said to you "Live!"

***Exodus 19:4-6** You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites.

***Psalm 34:18** The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

2 Corinthians 1:4-8 ...who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.

For just as we share abundantly in the sufferings of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ.

If we are distressed, it is for your comfort and salvation; if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which produces in you patient endurance of the same sufferings we suffer.

And our hope for you is firm, because we know that just as you share in our sufferings, so also you share in our comfort.

***Acts 3:21** Heaven must receive him until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets.

***Amos 9:14** and I will bring my people Israel back from exile. They will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit.

***Isaiah 57:15** For this is what the high and exalted One says— he who lives forever, whose name is holy: I live in a high and holy place, but also with the one who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite.

***Jeremiah 30:17** But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds, declares the LORD, because you are called an outcast, Zion for whom no one cares.

***I Peter 5:10** And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

***Luke 19:9-10** Jesus said to him, Today salvation has come to this house, because this man too is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

***Ephesians 2:11-13 & 19** Therefore remember that formerly you who are Gentiles in the flesh and called uncircumcised by the so-called circumcision That at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: **But now in Yeshua HaMashiach** you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Mashiach.... Therefore **you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of God's household,**

***Deuteronomy 16:10-11a** Then you shall keep the Feast of Weeks to the LORD your God with the tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give as the LORD your God blesses you. **You shall rejoice before the LORD your God.....**

***Deuteronomy 26:10-11** And now, behold, I have brought the first fruits of the land that You, O LORD, have given me. Then you are to place the basket before the LORD your God and bow down before Him. **So you shall rejoice** - you, the Levite, and the foreigner dwelling among you - in all the good things the LORD your God has given to you and your household.

***Revelation 21:4** And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, no sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.

***Revelation 22:3-5** No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His servants will worship Him. They will see His face, and His name will be on their foreheads. And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for He, the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever.

***Deuteronomy 16:11** and **you shall rejoice before the LORD your God** in the place He will choose as a dwelling for His Name—you, your sons and daughters, your menservants and maidservants, and the Levite within your gates, as well as the foreigner, the fatherless, and the widows among you.

***Ecclesiastes 3:12** I know that there is nothing better for people than to **rejoice and do good while they live.**

***Ecclesiastes 3:22** So I saw that there is nothing better for a person than to rejoice in his work, because that is his lot.

***Ecclesiastes 8:15** So I commend rejoicing in life, because there is nothing better for a person under the sun than to eat and drink and rejoice.

***Ecclesiastes 11:8** However many years anyone may live, let him rejoice in them all.

***Philippians 4:4** Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice.

***Romans 15:13** May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

***Nehemiah 8:10b** And do not be grieved, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.

***John 15:11** I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy.
