



Torah Portion - VaYishlach - And He Sent - Edom's Final End
December 2, 2023 - Kislev 19, 5784
Genesis 32:3-36:43; Obadiah 1-21; Matthew 2:12-23

***Joel 3:2** I will gather all the nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will enter into judgment against them concerning My people, My inheritance, Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations as they divided up My land.

***Genesis 31:20-22** And Jacob stole away, unknown to Laban the Syrian, in that he did not tell him that he intended to flee. So he fled with all that he had. He arose and crossed the river, and headed toward the mountains of Gilead. And Laban was told on the third day that Jacob had fled.

***Genesis 32:1-2** So Jacob went on his way and the angels of God met him. Jacob said when he saw them, A camp of God is this! So he called the name of that place Mahanaim.

***Hebrews 1:14** Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

***Psalm 91:11** Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

***Deuteronomy 32:9** For the Lord's portion is His people;

***Genesis 32:11** I am unworthy of all the kindnesses and of all the truth that You have done with Your servant; for with my staff I crossed this Jordan.

***Genesis 32:4** Then Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother to the land of Seir, the field of Edom.

***Genesis 32:5** He commanded them, saying Thus shall you say to my lord, to Esau, So said your servant Jacob: With Laban I have sojourned, and I have lingered until now.

***Psalms 118:6** The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

***Psalm 27:1** The Lord is my light and my salvation - whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life - of whom shall I be afraid?

***Genesis 32:7** The messengers returned to Jacob, saying We came to your brother, to Esau; moreover, he is coming toward you and four hundred men are with him.

***Genesis 32:8** Jacob became frightened exceedingly, and it **distressed** him.

***Genesis 32:9-10** So he divided the people who were with him and the flock, the cattle and the camels into two camps. For he said, If Esau comes to the one camp and strikes it, then it will be that the camp that remains may escape.

***Genesis 32:10-13** Then Jacob said, "O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, the Lord who said to me, 'Return to your country and to your family, and **I will deal well with you**': I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies and of all the truth which You have shown Your servant; for I crossed over this Jordan with my staff, and now I have become two companies. Deliver me, I pray, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau; for I fear him, lest he come and attack me and the mother with the children. For You said, 'I will surely treat you well, and make your descendants as the sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered for multitude.' "

***Genesis 32:17-21** And he commanded the first one, saying, "When Esau my brother meets you and asks you, saying, 'To whom do you belong, and where are you going? Whose are these in front of you?' then you shall say, 'They are your servant Jacob's. It is a present sent to my lord Esau; and behold, he also is behind us.' " So he commanded the second, the third, and all who followed the droves, saying, "In this manner you shall speak to Esau when you find him; and also say, 'Behold, your servant Jacob is behind us.' " For he said, "I will appease him with the present that goes before me, and afterward **I will see his face**; perhaps he will accept me." So the present went on over before him, but he himself lodged that night in the camp.

***Genesis 32:22-24** And he arose that night and took his wives, his two female servants, and his eleven sons and crossed over the ford of Jabbok. He took them, sent them over the brook and sent over what he had. Then Jacob was left alone ; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.

***Romans 8:29** For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son.

***2 Corinthians 3:18** And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

***Romans 12:2** Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

***I Corinthians 15:49** Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust [Adam], we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven [Yeshua].

***Romans 12:1** I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

***Genesis 32:25-26** When the man saw that he could not overpower Jacob, he struck the socket of Jacob's hip and dislocated it as they wrestled. Then the man said, "Let me go, for it is daybreak." But Jacob replied, "I will not let you go unless you bless me."

***Genesis 32:27-28** So He said to him, what is your name? He said, Jacob. And He said, Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed.

***Revelation 2:17** To everyone who conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give a white stone, and on the white stone is written a new name that no one knows but the one who receives it.

***Genesis 18:27-28** And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which am but dust and ashes: peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for lack of five? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy it.

***Exodus 4:10-12** But Moses said to the LORD, "Please, Lord, I have never been a skilled speaker. Even now, after talking to you, I cannot speak well. I speak slowly and can't find the best words." Then the LORD said to him, "Who made a person's mouth?

***Genesis 32:30-31** So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved. Just as he crossed over Penuel the sun rose on him, and he limped on his hip.

***Obadiah 1:1&3** Thus says the Lord GOD concerning Edom. (We have heard a report from the LORD, and a messenger has been sent among the nations, saying, Arise, and let us rise up against her for battle...The pride of your heart. Has deceived you. You who dwell

in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high, you who say in your heart, Who will bring me down to the ground?

***Obadiah 1:10-11** For violence against your brother Jacob, Shame shall cover you, And you shall be cut off forever. In the day that you stood on the other side— In the day that strangers carried captive his forces, When foreigners entered his gates And cast lots for Jerusalem— Even you were as one of them.

***Deuteronomy 2:22** The LORD had done the same for the descendants of Esau, who lived in Seir, when he destroyed the Horites from before them. They drove them out and have lived in their place to this day.

***Obadiah 1:14** You should not have stood at the crossroads to cut off those among them who escaped; Nor should you have delivered up those among them who remained in the day of distress.

***Genesis 36:9** These are the generations of Esau the *father of the Edomites* in the hill country of Seir.

***Genesis 36:12** Timna was a concubine of Eliphaz, Esau's son; she bore Amalek to Eliphaz.

***Exodus 17:16** for he said, Because the LORD has sworn: the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.

***I Chronicles 4:42a-43** Now some of them five hundred men of the sons of Simeon, went to Mt. Seir.....And they defeated the rest of the Amalekites who had escaped. They have dwelt there to this day.

***Numbers 20: 20-21** Again they answered: "You may not pass through."

Then Edom came out against them with a large and powerful army. Since Edom refused to let them go through their territory, Israel turned away from them.

***Obadiah 1:10** For violence against your brother Jacob, shame shall cover you and you shall be cut off forever.

***Obadiah 1:15** For the day of the LORD upon all the nations is near;

***Ezekiel 30:3** For the day is near, even the day of the LORD is near; it will be a day of clouds, the time of the Gentiles.

***Joel 2;2** It is a day of darkness and gloom, a day of thick clouds and deep blackness. Suddenly, like dawn spreading across the mountains, a great and mighty army appears. Nothing like it has been seen before or will ever be seen again.

***Matthew 24:21** For at that time there will be great tribulation, unmatched from the beginning of the world until now, and never to be seen again.

***Revelation 9:2** The star opened the pit of the Abyss, and smoke rose out of it like the smoke of a great furnace, and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke from the pit.

***Obadiah 17-18** But on Mount Zion there shall be deliverance, And there shall be holiness; The house of Jacob shall possess their possessions. The house of Jacob shall be a fire, And the house of Joseph a flame; But the house of Esau shall be stubble; They shall kindle them and devour them, And no survivor shall remain of the house of Esau, For the LORD has spoken.

***Obadiah1:21** Then saviors shall come to Mount Zion, to judge the mountains of Esau and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

***Genesis 33:16-17a** And Esau went back on his way to Seir that day, and Jacob traveled to Sukkot.....
